RESOLUTION NO. 3250 - THE NORTH STREET RECONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, The City of Stamford has published a legal notice and a display ad, mailed a news release to a number of officials and agencies, and mailed a formal letter to abutting property owners and neighborhood residents, announcing a public informational meeting on the proposed STP Urban Transportation project known as Project # 135-302, North Street Reconstruction.

WHEREAS, a public information meeting was held on Tuesday, May 13, 1997 at 7:00 P.M at the Stamford Government Center Cafeteria located on the 4th Floor of 888 Washington Boulevard, Stamford, at which residents had an opportunity to voice their concern, and

WHEREAS, the South Western Regional Planning Agency is in favor of including this project in the Transportation Improvement Program and to utilize federal for right of way and construction activities, and


