RESOLUTION NO. 3535 TO CREATE A STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL (SAC) TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES' EDUCATION COMMITTEE

Whereas, the Stamford Public Schools serve a diverse student body with over 15,000 students; and

Whereas, students are the District's "clients" and we should make every effort to engage them and seek their feedback; and

Whereas, there is no student council structure on a district level; and

Whereas, the Board of Representatives Education Committee is committed to improving communication and services to all District students it recommends establishing a Student Advisory Council (SAC); and

Whereas, the Student Advisory Council (SAC) will be comprised of an equal number of male and female students from the following Stamford Public High schools (the number of students indicated in parentheses): Stamford High School (4), Westhill High School (4), AITE (2), ARTS Program (2) and Stamford Academy (2); and

Whereas, the composition of the SAC is subject to change at the request and approval of the Education Committee and subject to board approval; and


Whereas, students on the SAC would serve for one school year term only; and

Whereas, the SAC will meet monthly in conjunction with meetings of the Education Committee;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the 28th Board of Representatives that a Student Advisory Council be established.
