

Dear Mr. Martin:

The City of Stamford has received a federal funding agreement from the State of Connecticut in the amount of \$868,840 of which the maximum amount of municipal reimbursement is \$654,560. This agreement facilitates the construction of a bicycle/pedestrian path along the Mill River from Tresser Boulevard to Broad Street including landscaping and lighting. The municipality, by accepting the terms and conditions of the award, agrees to be responsible for the construction phase of the project which includes, but is not limited to, administration, inspection, and construction engineering services.
