RESOLUTION NO. 3459 Authorizing the Mayor to File a Grant Application with the State of Connecticut and accept funding for Activities associated with the 2011 Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3

WHEREAS, Title III of Division B of the Housing and Economic Recovery Act (the "HERA") of 2008 (P.L. 110-289) (October 6, 2008) as amended by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (the "ARRA") of 2009 (P.L. 111-5), and 73 FR 58330 Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 (P.L. 111-203) (effective July 21, 2010) allocated \$9,322,756 in federal monies to the State of Connecticut to be considered as Community Development Block Grant Funds (CDBG) for the redevelopment of abandoned and foreclosed upon homes and residential properties (the Neighborhood Stabilization Program or NSP); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 127c, and Part VI of Chapter 130 of Connecticut General Statutes, the Commissioner of the State of Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development is authorized to disburse such federal monies to local municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Connecticut's 2011 Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 Action Plan Substantial Amendment (NSP3) requires that each subrecipient (as the term is defined in the Action Plan) submit an application to the State of Connecticut, Department of Economic and Community Development (State or DECD) in order to receive funds allocated to said subrecipient; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the public interest that the CITY OF STAMFORD make an application to the State for \$380,000.00 in order to make funding commitments using CDBG grant NSP funds for activities associated with the 2011 Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 Action Plan Substantial Amendment (NSP3), including the disbursement of such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD:

1. That it is cognizant of the conditions and prerequisites for the state financial assistance imposed by Part VI of Chapter 30 of the CGS.
2. That the filing of an application for State financial assistance by the CITY OF STAMFORD in an amount not to exceed \$380,000.00 is hereby approved and

that MICHAEL A. PAVIA, MAYOR is directed to execute and file such application with the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development, to provide such additional information, to execute such other documents as may be required, to execute an Assistance Agreement with the State of Connecticut for State financial assistance if such an agreement is offered, to execute any amendments, decisions, and revisions thereto and all other documents required by the State or HUD for the receipt of CDBG grant NSP funds as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution and in accordance with all applicable law, to administer funds as required, and to act as the authorized representative of the CITY OF STAMFORD.

This resolution was approved on the Consent Agenda at the regular monthly meeting of the 28th Board of Representatives held on Monday, December 5, 2011.
