RESOLUTION NO. 3379 RESOLUTION APPROVING SUBMITTAL OF ATTACHED LIST OF PROGRAMS TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SERVICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONNECTICUT NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE ACT

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Connecticut has enacted the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act (P.A. 95-258) enabling Connecticut businesses to receive tax credits for contributions to organizations and programs approved as eligible and beneficial to the community by the legislative body of each municipality; and


WHEREAS, the City of Stamford recognizes the clear need for financial operating support to many local organizations and programs which provide Stamford residents with neighborhood assistance, crime prevention, day care, energy conservation or other services particularly benefiting individuals whose incomes fall below 150% of the Federal poverty level.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 28TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS ATTACHED HERETO CONSTITUTE A LIST WHICH SHALL BE SUBMITTED ON OR BEFORE July 1, 2010 to the Commissioner of the Connecticut Department of Revenue Services as programs determined to be eligible for receipt of private business contributions under the provisions of the Act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, acting through the City's Grants Officer, Karen Cammarota, shall be the designee in accordance with the legislation to provide such additional information as may be required to oversee implementation of the resulting programs receiving private business contributions under the Act. Said programs shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religious creed, age, marital status, national origin, ancestry, sex, mental retardation, sexual orientation, or physical disability, including but not limited to, blindness, in the provision of services.

This resolution shall be come effective upon its enactment.

This resolution was approved by unanimous voice vote at the regular monthly meeting of the 28th Board of Representatives held on Monday, June 7, 2010.
