RESOLUTION NO. 3237
NOTICE OF INTENT TO DISCONTINUE
THE WEST MAIN STREET BRIDGE
AS A PUBLIC ACCESS VEHICULAR TRAFFIC BRIDGE
STAMFORD, CONNECTICUT

WHEREAS, the Mayor has presented a proposal to convert the bridge on West Main Street that crosses the Mill River (the "West Main Street Bridge") to a pedestrian bridge with emergency vehicular access; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said proposal, the Mayor has requested that the Board of Representatives, pursuant to Sec. C8-60-1 *et. seq.* of the Charter and Sec. 240-40 *et. seq.* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford, declare by resolution its intention to discontinue the West Main Street Bridge as a public access vehicular traffic bridge;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 27TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

The Board of Representatives hereby declares its intention, based on the requirements of public health, safety and welfare, convenience and necessity, to discontinue the West Main Street Bridge as a public access vehicular traffic bridge; and

Pursuant to the aforesaid provisions of the Charter and Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford, the Mayor is hereby requested to cause a report to be made on the contemplated discontinuance of the West Main Street Bridge as a public access vehicular traffic bridge.

This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of approval.

This resolution was approved by a machine vote of 23-11-0 at the regular monthly meeting of the 27th Board of Representatives held on Monday, June 2, 2008.
