WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, at the request of the Mill River Collaborative, is contemplating the discontinuance of the portion of West Park Place west of Washington Boulevard, Stamford, Connecticut, which is owned by the City of Stamford; and


WHEREAS, that portion of West Park Place which the Board of Representatives is contemplating discontinuing begins at land owned by the City of Stamford at the intersection of West Park Place and Washington Boulevard and continues west to the end of the road.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

The public health, safety, welfare, convenience and necessity may require the discontinuance of a portion of West Park Place; and

Pursuant to the provisions of the Section C8-60-3 of the Charter of said City of Stamford, the Mayor is hereby requested to cause a report to be made on the contemplated discontinuance of that portion of West Park Place as is more particularly described hereinabove.
