RESOLUTION NO. 3174 RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAYOR TO APPOINT A BLIGHT ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Public Act 06-185 authorizes municipalities to levy special assessments on blighted properties; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 06-185 requires that municipalities adopt an enabling ordinance before it may begin levying special assessments on blighted properties; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 06-185 further requires that, prior to adoption of an enabling ordinance, the chief executive of a municipality appoint a committee to investigate a special assessment program; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 06-185 further requires that said investigatory committee undertake and complete, within a period not in excess of sixty days following such appointment, a study and investigation with respect to such special assessment program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to have an investigatory committee consider the suitability of a special assessment program for the City of Stamford.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, does hereby request that Mayor Malloy appoint a blight assessment investigatory committee consistent with the provisions of Public Act 06-185, and further request that Mayor Malloy charge such committee to carry out the duties expressly provided in said public act.

This resolution will take effect upon enactment.

This resolution was approved by unanimous voice vote at the regular monthly meeting of the 27th Board of Representatives held on Monday, July 2, 2007.
