RESOLUTION NO. 3311
RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING JURISDICTION OF
83 LOCKWOOD AVENUE TO THE CITY OF STAMFORD

WHEREAS, Section 9-12 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford requires approval of the Board of Representatives of any transfer of jurisdiction over buildings or land owned by the city, between departments, boards or agencies of the city; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Education currently has jurisdiction over the premises located at 83 Lockwood Avenue, Stamford, formerly known as the "Rogers School"; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative and Rules Committee of the Board of Representatives has recommended approval of leases of portions of the building located at 83 Lockwood Avenue, Stamford, Connecticut, to The Domus Foundation, Inc. and to the Childcare Learning Center, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to lease said property to The Domus Foundation, Inc. and to the Childcare Learning Center, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the 27th Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford hereby transfers jurisdiction of the property located at 83 Lockwood Avenue, Stamford, Connecticut, formerly known as the Rogers School to the City of Stamford, as required by Section 9-12..
