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
RESOLUTION NO. 3383 CONCERNING RECYCLABLES FEES

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to impose a fee on commercial haulers and other non-residential users of the City's transfer station to cover the cost of disposing of recyclable materials .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, pursuant to Section 137-32 of the Code of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve a Recyclables Fee of \$15 per ton for recyclable materials to be imposed on commercial haulers and other non-residential users of the City' transfer station.

This resolution will take effect July 15, 2010.

This resolution was approved by unanimous voice vote at the regular monthly meeting of the 28th Board of Representatives held on Monday, June 7, 2010.
