

Kies' Big East run drawing praise

Naismith Hall of Fame and has two NCAA championships, saying that a five-game run through the Big East is one of his most special accomplishments is shouting volumes.

It's certainly left a couple of his Big East coaching brethren here at the NCAA tournament speaking words of praise.

"They said playing four games in four days" that no one would ever do it and then when they made the tournament five games, they said no one would ever do it. And now, somebody did it," said Dixon, whose Pitt team won the 2008 tournament, winning four games in four days. "It's something that people said couldn't be done. They played well, they won close games."

Added Cronin: "I don't know of anybody, other than their coach and the kids in that locker room that thought that was possible. We played on

a Tuesday last year and we won and we won on Wednesday, and Thursday, we lost on a bank at the buzzer. I remember thinking, 'What if we had to play two more?' I distinctly remember thinking that. I thought my team was tired on Thursday.

"I would give Kemba Walker all the credit. Obviously, UConn gets their toughness from their coach and that's a big factor, but Kemba is such an extraordinary talent, he clearly elevates everyone around him. When he's at his best, they're a different team. He just put the team on his back."

Walker scored a tournament-record 130 points in the five games. Over those five days, Walker thrived on the pressure.

But afterward, as when it hit Calhoun on the bus ride home, the majesty of the moment also hit Walker.

"I don't think there's been a day (since the tournament ended) that's gone by where I haven't said, 'Wow, we really won the Big East championship,'" Walker said. "It was definitely surprising, we just accomplished so much."
