**RESOLUTION NO. 3510**  
*(formerly Resolution No. 3443)*  
**WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF  
SECTION 21-3B OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN ORDER TO  
RENAME THE FIELD AT BOYLE STADIUM ANDY ROBUSTELLI FIELD**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 21-1 of the Code of Ordinances, a request to rename the field at Boyle Stadium at Stamford High School in memory of the late Andy Robustelli was submitted to the Board of Representatives; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 21-3B of the Code of Ordinances provides that a park or facility may be named to memorialize any person, inter alia, who has been deceased for more than six months prior to the request and contributed substantially to the establishment of such park or facilities or due to such person's contribution to the entire community; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 21-3B of the Code of Ordinance provides that upon a showing of good cause, the Board of Representatives may waive any of the aforementioned requirements by a resolution of 2/3 of the entire Board; and

**WHEREAS**, Andrew Richard Robustelli was born on Dec. 6, 1925, in Stamford, where his father, Lucien, was a barber, and his mother, Katie, was a seamstress, and was a life-long resident of Stamford; and

**WHEREAS**, Andy Robustelli attended Stamford High School, where he played football, baseball and basketball, and after serving in the United States Navy during World War II, attended Arnold College in Milford, CT; and

**WHEREAS**, Andy Robustelli was drafted by the Los Angeles Rams in the 19<sup>th</sup> round of the 1951 NFL draft; played in eight N.F.L. championship games, two with the Rams and six with the Giants after joining them in 1956; was a first-team All-Pro six times; received the Maxwell Club's Bert Bell Award as the N.F.L.'s most outstanding player in 1962; and was elected to the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 1971; and

**WHEREAS**, after retiring as a player at the end of the 1964 season, Andy Robustelli expanded his business interests, opening a travel agency and a sports marketing business in Stamford; and

**WHEREAS**, Andy Robustelli died on May 31, 2011 and was not deceased for six months prior to the request that the field be renamed.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 28<sup>TH</sup> BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT**

it waives the requirement of Section 21-1 of the Code of Ordinances mandating that any park or facility be named after persons who have been deceased for at least six months.


This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.


This resolution was approved by unanimous voice vote at the regular monthly meeting of the 28th Board of Representatives held on Monday, August 1, 2011.
