Whereas, Nick Koules was a longtime umpire and official at Stamford's youth athletic activities; and


Whereas, Nick Koules ; and


Whereas, Nick Koules was a former semi-professional basketball player and was inducted into the Fairfield County Sports Hall of Fame in 2007; and
