**PROPOSED RESOLUTION
ESTABLISHING A MOORING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to establish fees for the mooring of vessels in the Stamford Harbor Management Area to be charged by the Stamford Harbor Management Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Stamford Harbor Management Commission met on February 23, 2010 and approved proposed fees; and

WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Committee of the 28th Board of Representatives considered the proposed fees at its April 20, 2010 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Committee of the Board of Representatives held a public hearing and met and approved the following fees on May 18, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 28th Board of Representatives, pursuant to and within the limitations of Sec. C2-10-2(6) of the Charter of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve the fees for the mooring of vessels in the Stamford Harbor Management Area.

The annual fee for an individual-private mooring permit issued by the Stamford Harbor Master shall be \$75.00 per vessel.

Non-profit organizations shall be charged an initial mooring permit fee of \$75.00 and a reduced annual fee of \$5.00 for each permitted vessel for up to six mooring locations. All such vessels must be registered with the State of Connecticut for the reduced fee available to non-profit organizations authorized under Chap. 68, Sec. 15-144b of the Connecticut General Statutes.

This resolution is effective upon enactment.
