**PROPOSED ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 23, FINANCES, TO PROVIDE FOR
FUNDING OF CLERK OF THE WORKS CONTRACTS**

WHEREAS, Section 40-83 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford provides that the City may hire individuals as Clerk of Works for defined projects; and

WHEREAS, the City routinely hires individuals as Clerk of Works to manage, oversee or otherwise assist on one or more Capital Projects, as defined in Section C1-10-4 of the Charter of the City of Stamford; and

WHEREAS, the task of determining whether a Clerk of the Works position for a particular project is funded out of the capital projects budget or operating budget is most appropriately accomplished by the Director of Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Stamford to ensure that the Director of Administration determines whether individuals hired to fill the position of Clerk of Works are funded out of the capital projects budget or operating budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Chapter 23 (Finances) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford is hereby amended by the addition of the following.

Sec. 23-30. Clerk of Works.

A. The Director of Administration may elect to hire one or more individuals as Clerk of Works for one or more defined projects for a term not to exceed three years.

B. The Director of Administration shall determine whether the position of the Clerk of the Works shall be funded out of the capital projects budget or the operating budget, pursuant to Charter Sections C8-20-1 through C8-20-11, and C8-30-1 through C8-30-11, as appropriate.

This ordinance will take effect upon enactment.
