**PROPOSED ADDITIONS TO THE CITY OF STAMFORD
MOORING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 28th Board of Representatives, pursuant to and within the limitations of Sec. C2-10-2(6) of the Charter of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve the fees for the commercial mooring of vessels in the Stamford Harbor Management Area.

The annual fee for a commercial mooring permit issued by the Stamford Harbor Master for a managed mooring field duly approved by the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers shall be equal to the amount determined by multiplying the number of moorings designated for that field by the amount of \$50.00 per mooring.

The annual fee for a commercial mooring permit issued by the Stamford Harbor Master for an individual mooring utilized for commercial purposes outside of a duly approved managed mooring field shall be the maximum amount permitted by state law.
