RESOLUTION NO. 3386 RESOLUTION URGING THE ADMINISTRATION TO INSTALL A POLICE SUBSTATION IN THE FORMER SOUTH END FIRE STATION

WHEREAS, the City of Stamford is the owner of property located at 670 Pacific Street, Stamford, CT, commonly known as the old South End Fire Station; and

WHEREAS, there is tremendous commercial and residential development currently taking place in the South End of Stamford and more is anticipated; and

WHEREAS, because of this extensive development, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Stamford to have a permanent police substation located in the South End of Stamford; and

WHEREAS, the old South End Fire Station is centrally located in the South End of the City, at the southeast corner of Pacific and Henry Streets, and would be an appropriate location for a police substation; and

WHEREAS, the old South End Fire Station is the oldest firehouse in the City of Stamford and is in need of repairs; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Stamford for the City to explore the extent of the repairs necessary to make the old South End Fire Station usable as a police substation as well as possible sources of funding for these repairs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the 28th Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford urges the Mayor and the administration of the City of Stamford, in connection with the Stamford Police Department, to explore the possibility of establishing a police substation at the old South End Fire Station, including the extent of the repairs necessary to make the old South End Fire Station usable as a police substation as well as possible sources of funding for these repairs.

The Above resolution shall be effective upon enactment.
