RESOLUTION NUMBER 3452 CONCERNING CHARTER REVISION AND THE APPOINTMENT OF THE 17TH CHARTER REVISION COMMISSION MEMBERS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C1-40-5 of the City of Stamford Charter, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 7-188 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, the Board of representatives has initiated the process of charter revision; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-190(a) of said General Statutes provides that within thirty days of such action, the appointment authority shall by resolution appoint a commission consisting of not fewer than five nor more than fifteen electors, not more than one-third of whom may hold any other public office in the municipality and not more than a bare majority of whom may hold any other public office in the municipality and not more than a bare majority of whom shall be members of any one political party; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives has completed its process of interviewing and selecting people to serve on the 17th Charter Review Commission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 28TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section C1-40-5 of the City of Stamford Charter, and in accordance with the provisions of § 7-188 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, the process of charter revision is hereby initiated.
2. Pursuant to Section 7-190 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford hereby appoints the 17th Charter Revision Commission.
3. The 17th Charter Revision Commission shall be composed of fifteen (15) members, not more than a bare majority being members of any one political party and not more than one-third holding any form of public office in the City.

4. The members of the 17th Charter Revision Commission shall be the following:


