Malloy was ordained as a priest on May 9, 1970 by The Most Reverend Walter Curtis, S.T.D., in St. Augustine’s Cathedral in Bridgeport, CT, officiating his first mass on May 10, 1970 at St. Gabriel’s Church in Stamford, and since that day has served his congregations in many ways, in addition to performing countless weddings and baptisms for the Malloy family alone; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Joseph J. Malloy served as an associate priest at St. James Church in Stratford, CT and at St. Catherine Church in Nichols, CT; as Pastor of St. Ann Church in Bridgeport, CT from 1987 to 2002; and as Pastor of St. Clement of Rome Church in Stamford, CT since 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Joseph J. Malloy served his country as a 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant in the Reserve Army Chaplain Corps. from 1968 to 1973; and as a Captain, Civil Air Patrol, Stratford Eagle Squadron from 1973 to 1975; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Joseph J. Malloy is a certified Firefighter 1, a Life Member of the Nichols Fire Department, and was a member of the Bridgeport Fire Department from 1992 through 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Joseph J. Malloy is admired and cherished by not only the parishioners of St. Clement of Rome Church but also the many citizens of Stamford.
