

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION
THANKING RON ROSENFELD FOR HIS 25 YEARS OF PUBLIC SERVICE
AND FUND-RAISING EFFORTS**

WHEREAS, Ron Rosenfeld, who owned the Athletes Foot on Summer Street in Stamford for the past 25 years, has a long history of promoting health and fitness in the Stamford community; and

WHEREAS, Ron Rosenfeld has finished 13 marathons, is a past president of the Stamford running club, has been a race director for 26 years and has been an assistant track coach at Ridgefield High School; and

WHEREAS, since 1979, Ron Rosenfeld has sponsored the Athlete's Foot Run/Walk 5K for Cancer, raising money for the Burke Rehabilitation Center and wheelchair participants and purchasing at least eight power wheelchairs for disabled children out of the proceeds of the race; and

WHEREAS, Ron Rosenfeld and his wife, Tina, received the Runners' World Award for Community Service for organizing a 5K road race, *Wheelchair Athletes*, that for 25 years raised awareness and money for disabled athletes; and

WHEREAS, Ron Rosenfeld has been a strong supporter of Stamford high school students, by employing hundreds of students over the years and by providing awards for the city championship track meets.
