

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING
DANTE TEREZIO OF TRINITY CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL
ON WINNING THE 2010 STATE OPEN SINGLES FINAL**

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2010; Dante Terenzio defeated Ryan Carr of Fairfield Prep 6-1, 6-2 in the 2010 State Open Singles final in Hamden; and

WHEREAS, with this win, Dante Terenzio defended his 2009 title; and

WHEREAS, Dante Terenzio is the first back-to-back State Open singles champion since 2006-2007; and

WHEREAS, the FCIAC is considered the toughest boys tennis league in the State of Connecticut; and

WHEREAS, Dante Terenzio was described by Mr. Carr as hitting “everything with deep spin and power” and hitting “groundstrokes so clean and well;” and

WHEREAS, Dante Terenzio’s determination was evident to all and a key to his success; and

WHEREAS, Dante Terenzio has earned a college scholarship to play tennis for Louisville University; and

WHEREAS, Dante Terenzio is one of just forty players in the United States to earn a National high School Tennis All-American honor; and

WHEREAS, this victory was achieved not only due to Mr. Terenzio’s skill and commitment but also because of the support of Dante’s parents and the rest of the Trinity High School community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the 28th Board of Representatives that it congratulates Dante Terenzio on winning the 2010 State Open Singles Final and on defending his 2009 title.
