WHEREAS, Michael E. Kraynak oversaw a wide range of Environmental Health Division activities from housing code enforcement, food service establishment licensing and inspection, septic system approval, barber shop and beauty parlor inspections to weights and measures certification, microwave antenna installations and environmental health disaster preparedness; and

WHEREAS, Michael E. Kraynak has been a leader in housing code enforcement throughout the State of Connecticut and has served on the Statewide Housing Task Force, a group charged with creating the State Housing Code; and

WHEREAS, Michael E. Kraynak is one of the original group of housing code directors from Connecticut cities credited with creating the Housing Code Enforcement Officials of Connecticut in 1970; Mr. Kraynak has served as the group's President, Vice President, Secretary and as a member of its Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, Michael E. Kraynak has been a dedicated and committed professional in his field, a valuable employee of the City of Stamford, and has shown extraordinary compassion and concern through his efforts to provide safe housing and environmental conditions for Stamford's residents.
