

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION
THANKING LOUIS CASALE, JR. FOR HIS SERVICE
TO THE CITY OF STAMFORD AND
THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, Louis Casale has lived and worked in Stamford for the past 74 years; and

WHEREAS, in August 2003, Louis Casale was appointed to the Board of the Stamford Water Pollution Control Authority, ultimately serving two terms as Chairperson of the Board of the WPCA; and

WHEREAS, after the Executive Director of the WPCA resigned in June, 2011, Louis Casale stepped in to provide interim management oversight of the WPCA, and, as a volunteer, became intimately involved with the day-to-day operations of the WPCA, including holding weekly staff meetings with WPCA employees; and

WHEREAS, as of December 31, 2011, Louis Casale resigned as a member of the Board of the Stamford Water Pollution Control Authority; and

WHEREAS, Louis Casale's contributions and dedication to the WPCA and the City of Stamford during this period went far beyond that typically expected of a volunteer member of a City board; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the members of the 28th Board of Representatives extends their sincere thanks and appreciation to Louis Casale for his 8 years of service and dedication to the Stamford Water Pollution Control Authority.
